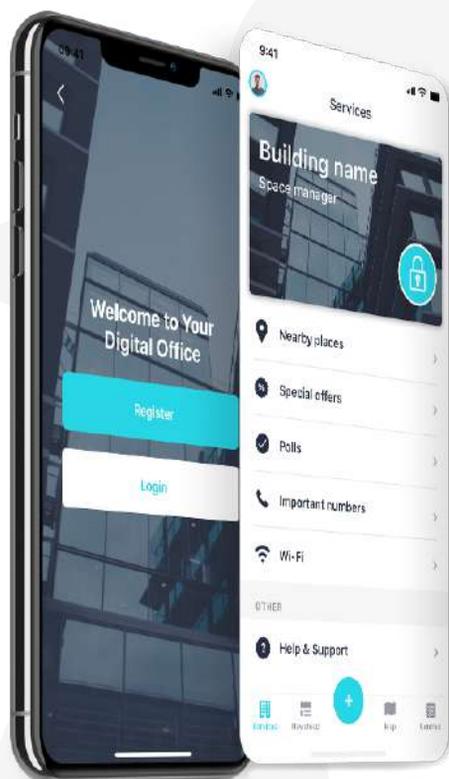

But it doesn't have to be like this.



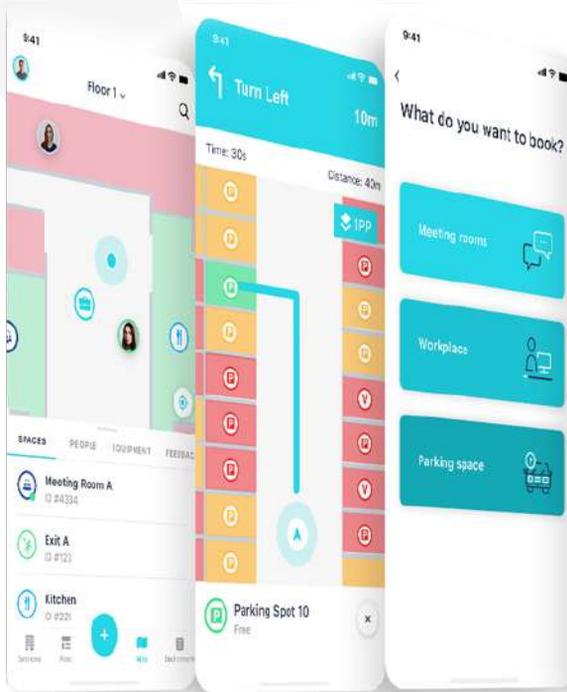

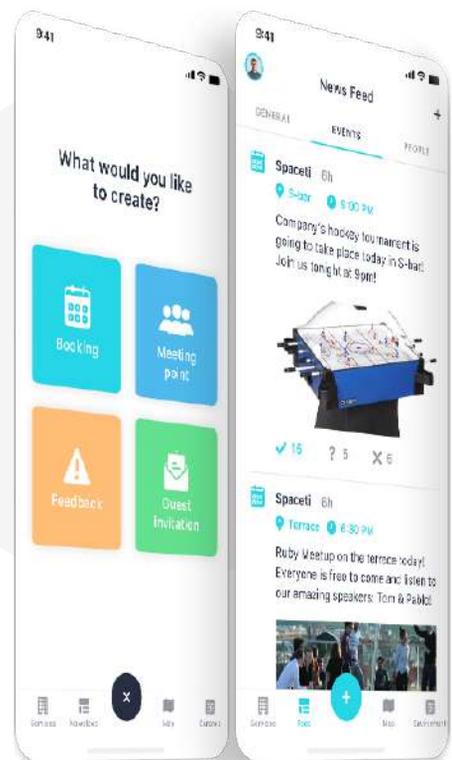

THE PROBLEM

So many companies are attempting to create truly flexible working environments. They know it's vitally important, especially when talent is scarce and so much work tends to be project-based. In London in 2018, for example, 50% of rented office space was classed as 'flexible'.

- But just how flexible are these work spaces?
- And are they being used to best effect?

Without reliable, real-time data, it's impossible to answer those questions.

As a result, some will opt for buildings that are too small. On busy days, frustrated employees wander the corridors in search of a desk, and end up in the cafeteria. Others go the other way, and end up with a huge building with a desk for everyone, despite the fact that there has never yet been a day when 'everyone' is in the office, and there never will be. As a result, vast amounts of valuable space are left unoccupied.

Poorly planned spaces are full of unhappy people. If they're lucky enough to find a meeting room, they arrive to find it's too hot, too cold, or too small... or double booked. They return to a desk that is far away from the people they need to work with, too noisy when they need to concentrate, or too quiet for a confidential conversation. They end up hiring expensive off-site locations for team meetings, despite the fact that half the office is effectively empty or underused.

These companies know that an agile, collaborative team culture is vital to their future success. They are desperate to achieve this. But without the data to support their decisions, there's a serious risk they will end up achieving the exact opposite.

It doesn't have to be like this. It really doesn't.

Lack of reliable, real-time data and analytics about the indoor environment leads to poor key management decisions and ineffective facility management.

Inflexible workspaces are uncomfortable, limit a team's ability to communicate and result in a poor user experience – the exact opposite to the highly productive, collaborative work environment that organisations need.

Businesses that don't innovate, die.

"Where Hot Desks are provided their utilisation is on average 16%, which is surprising given the nature of their supposed use..."

"Meeting room utilisation in most buildings is very poor with on average 39% of meeting rooms being used for the time they are available.

This picture however becomes worse when we examine the degree to which the seats in meeting rooms (i.e. their total capacity) are used with 19% of meeting room capacity being used."



THE POTENTIAL

Our lives are increasingly automated. We can control so much, so easily. Apps tell us where we are going, and how long it will take to get there. They help us to order the goods and services we need, when we need them. They can ensure our home will be warm and the water hot when we get home again. And we do all of this, and so much more, from a device we carry around with us.

So why do so many of us have to step back in time when we go to work? Why would you want to work for a company that is stuck on the 20th century?

Harvard Business School researchers compared the outcomes of flexible work arrangements at the US Patent and Trademark Office and found that **employees with liberal 'work from anywhere' arrangements were 4.4% more productive** than those following a more traditional 'work-from-home' policy.

A great Wi-Fi experience

High density environments are not known for great Wi-Fi, which is deeply frustrating for users and bad news for businesses who depend on it for communication and collaboration. 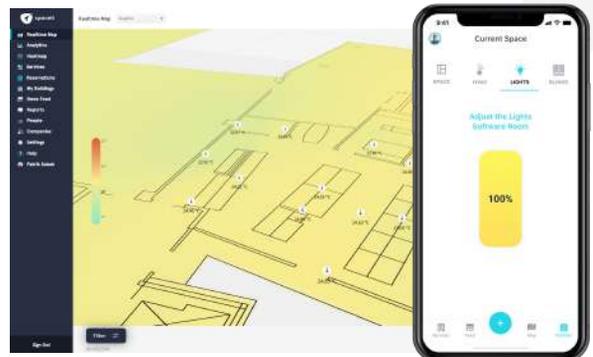
A healthy experience.

Create a pleasant workspace for your tenants and employees, and meet your environmental obligations at the same time. You can use our technology to monitor heat, humidity and light levels, and even CO₂, and so ensure that the space is healthy and compliant.

You can create, customise and schedule reports on the entire building, individual sections, floors, or rooms, for the time period of your choosing. And with just a few clicks, you can adjust lights, heating and ventilation in any part of your building.

Twenty-four participants spent 6 full work days (0900–1700 hours) in an environmentally controlled office space.

On different days, they were exposed to higher or lower concentrations of volatile organic compounds (VOCs) and artificially elevated levels of CO₂.



On average, cognitive scores were 101% higher on days where VOCs and CO₂ were low.

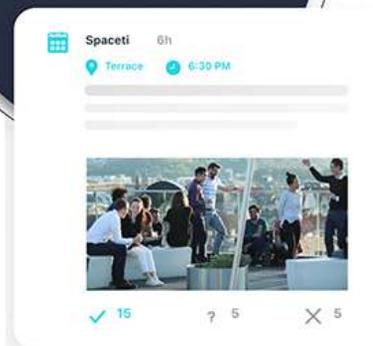
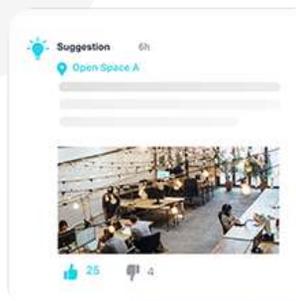
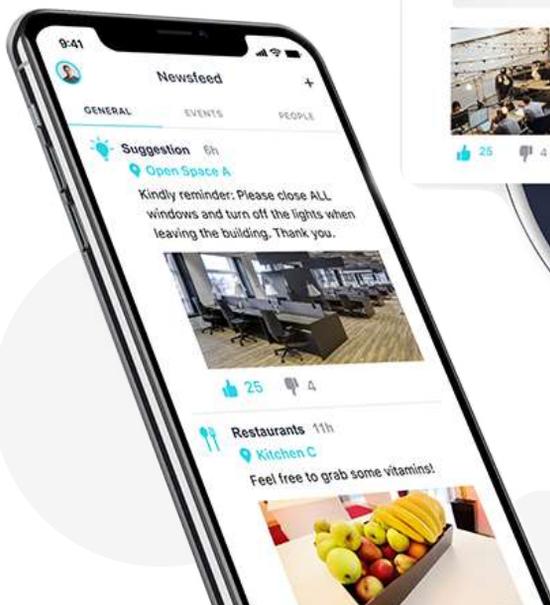
About our app
